Manages Transmission and Distribution Integrity Programs within Gas Operations, including all regulatory and procedural requirements documented in the integrity plans. Works with external consultants and vendors as well as various internal groups to meet required program deadlines. Also, communicates directly with Federal and State regulators, industry peers and professional organizations as the lead for these programs. Responsible for regulatory required programs related to corrosion, including monitoring, and mitigation.

### **Duties & Responsibilities:**

- Drives and directs the vision of Pipeline Integrity Management Programs for Gas Operations and oversees department compliance issues.
- Manages and oversees the Integrity Management workgroup as well as the Corrosion workgroup. Monitors both of these department's goals and performance,
- Communicates with Commission staffs and external pipeline safety personnel – PUCO, KPSC, and DOT.
- Oversees consulting and contractor workforce providing direct support for Integrity and Corrosion Engineering projects.
- Manages safe work method applications, safety management techniques and governmental requirements for operational work.
- Oversees approximate \$3M O&M budget for Integrity and Corrosion related projects.
